Participants will be selected according to the following criteria:

- Women who have obtained higher education or professional experience in their country of origin.
- Would benefit from career bridging and may otherwise forgo conventional settlement programming.
- Express readiness and willingness to work, although currently not working in their field of interest.
- Demonstrate adequate English language ability to be able to successfully participate in the program.
- CIC eligible (Permanent Resident, etc.)
